BRUSH PENS - Pentel Touch/Sign pen, Fudenosuke or any small tipped brush pen.

Other options for brush pens include Tombow ABT N15, Karin Pro marker Pen, Faber Castell Artist Pitt Pen.

PENCIL - Pilot mechanical pencil

PAPER - Rhodia dot or plain paper pad, high quality smooth HP paper, tracing paper, layout paper.





WARM UP EXERCISES

We need to get our writing hand warmed up before we dive in to the letter practice. These are great exercises to loosen up yor hand and to help you develop more precision with flow and rhythm. You can use a pencil or pen at this stage - it doesn't have to be perfect. Remember, you're just playing and getting used to the movement.




One way to start exploring flourishing is to think about extending the entry and exit strokes of a word...

TIP: Keep your pressure light on the paper and when it comes to shaping, keep the loops open and oval.



FLOURISHING DETAILS

Now lets take our practice further by applying the flourishes we warmed up with, to some letters. At this stage, we are exploring and understanding how and where to add embellishment to the ascender, descender and cross bars of letters. Have fun and experiment with the different possibilities. Here are a few examples...




TIP: Think about way's to fill the empty space around the letter.






FLOURISHED ALPHABET (C & D)














